

The estimated prevalence of Mucormycosis is around 70 times higher in India than that in global data. The increasing incidence of Rhino-Orbital-Cerebral Mucormycosis (ROCM) in this pandemic has become a matter of immediate concern. This fungal infection predisposed by diabetes mellitus, corticosteroids, immunosuppressive drugs and iron overload etc, becomes a potentially lethal disease. So, even a slight delay in diagnosis and appropriate management can have devastating implication on patient's survival. Let us understand the key to early diagnosis and its management.

Dental caries is the most common cause of tooth destruction in the children. So, early detection of dental caries can prevent loss of tooth structure. The incipient carious lesions are the lesions which are present at the initial phase of tooth decay. These lesions can be treated and hence preventing further tooth destruction. Most commonly these lesions appear as whitish spots on the enamel surface. There are various methods for the management of the incipient lesions, most effective being, use of remineralizing agents in the form of toothpastes, gels and varnishes, using anti plaque agents and use of fluorides. Dietary advices also play a very important role in the prevention of caries. Management of incipient lesions as early as possible can save the teeth and hence preventing the other issues that may arise from severe tooth destructions.

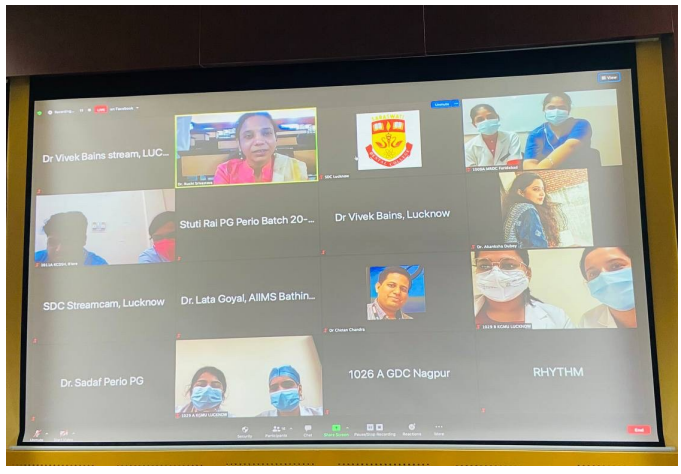
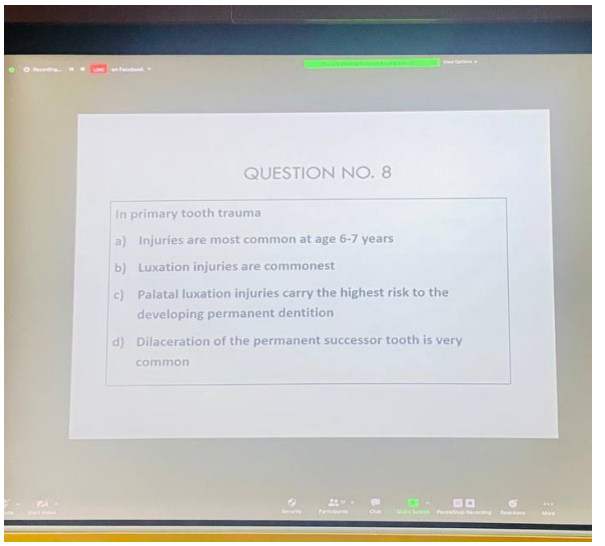

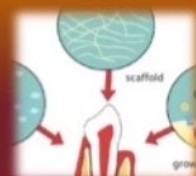

A young permanent tooth that becomes non vital due to trauma or caries poses a challenge for the clinician to manage. Open apex, short root and thin dentin makes the tooth vulnerable. Regenerative endodontic treatment (revascularization) is the newer treatment modality that has brought about a paradigm shift. The purpose of this presentation is to understand the basic concept which is based on principles of tissue engineering, learn the treatment procedure and various materials used. The clinical and radiographic outcomes of revascularization procedures will be discussed with relevant case series.

Malocclusions are developmental problems. These problems can be manifested in the form of dental, skeletal, soft tissue or combination of these problems. There is an evolution of concept from diagnosis to treatment planning and management of Orthodontic cases. Various contemporary appliances ranging from removable to fixed orthodontic appliances along with its versatile applications forced us to develop proper concept for management of orthodontic problems. Myofunctional appliances are useful to intercept the development of malocclusion. There are various myofunctional appliances used in orthodontic practice. The presentation highlights different contemporary myofunctional appliances along with considerations of diagnosis, treatment planning and correction/interception of malocclusion and their possible consequences.

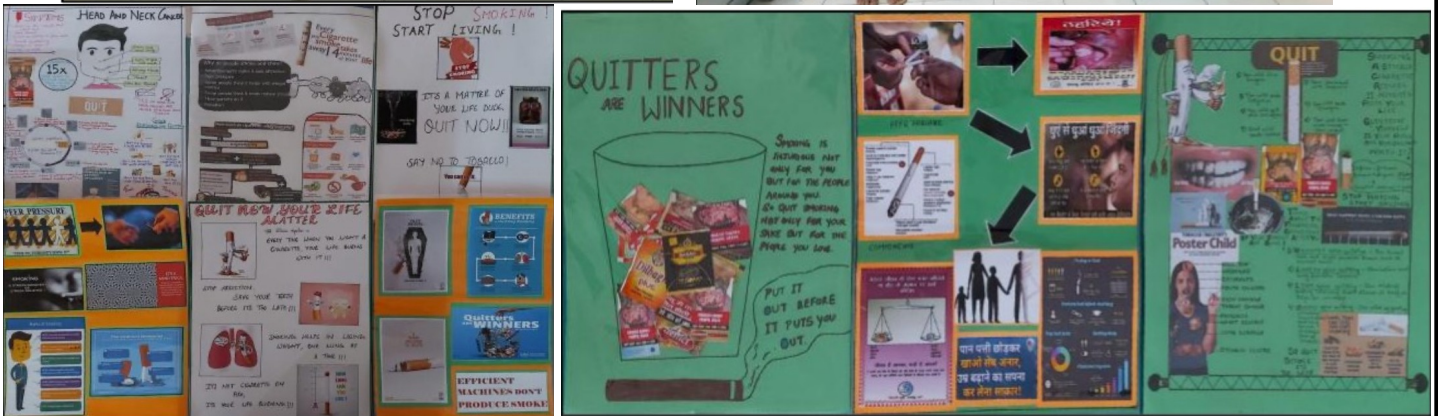

Oral cancer ranks in the top three of all cancers in India and is of significant public health importance. In majority of cases it is diagnosed at later stages which results in low treatment outcomes and considerable cost burden. The greatest threat of the oral cancer burden exists among the lower socioeconomic strata. This group is most vulnerable because of higher exposure to the risk factors like tobacco, limited access to education, prevention and treatment. Prevention and early diagnosis of potentially malignant disorder and oral cancer requires increased public awareness and educating practitioners to be skillful in identifying these pathology.


